



Bye Laws: Dress Code

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- 1. Club Approved Coloured Apparel**
 - 1.1 Every member of a side or team shall wear apparel of the same colour in all representative matches.
 - 1.2 Standard white or cream apparel rule shall apply in other cases.
- 2. Foot Apparel**
 - 2.1 May be a pair of any colour or combination of colours.
 - 2.2 May be lace-up, pull-on, or sandals with a backstrap.
 - 2.3 May not be backless, beach thongs or CROCS.
 - 2.4 Must be flat, smooth soled or ridged soled (Ridges must not be deeper than 2mm - match stick sizes).
- 3. Socks**
 - 3.1 Socks worn by men and women shall be white or cream.
 - 3.2 Ankle socks, secret socks or golf hose must be worn with shorts - predominately white.
- 4. Shirts / Blouses**
 - 4.1 Shirts shall have conventional collars and be adequately buttoned for both men and women.
- 5. Men's Trousers**
 - 5.1 Club approved coloured shorts shall be of regulation knee length.
 - 5.2 Club approved coloured shorts/trousers with or without zippers and pockets can be worn.
 - 5.3 String tied trousers (cricket trousers), tracksuit trousers or tracksuit shorts, without a front zip, approved by a club, district or member authority are also acceptable.
 - 5.4 Members of a team may wear shorts when playing EKB sanctioned tournaments.
 - 5.5 Under no circumstances shall Cargo, Combat, Denim trousers or rugby shorts be permitted.
- 6. Women's Shorts, Capri Pants, Tailored Slacks and Skorts**
 - 6.1 The minimum length of shorts shall be on the knee.
 - 6.2 The length of slacks shall be touching the instep.
 - 6.3 All women's apparel can be tailored with or without pockets.
 - 6.4 String tied trousers (cricket trousers), tracksuit trousers or tracksuit shorts, without a front zip, approved by a club, district or member authority are also acceptable.
 - 6.5 Players can wear skorts.
 - 6.6 Under no circumstances shall Cargo, Combat, Denim trousers or lycra shorts (or any other body clinging material) be permitted.
- 7. Headwear**
 - 7.1 CLUB-APPROVED or white hats can be worn with or without hatband.
 - 7.2 CLUB-APPROVED caps or peaks may be worn.

8. Windbreakers

CLUB-APPROVED colours or white or cream.

9. Cardigans / Jumpers

CLUB-APPROVED colours or white or cream.

10. District Apparel

District approved apparel may be worn/used when representing the district in an official event or during a representative match, in all events excluding club competitions and social bowls. As long as the team are uniformly dressed.

11. Official Attire

Refrain from wearing official attire when not on official duty or in that capacity.

12. Club Responsibility

Club Executives are to regulate and enforce the use of approved club colours and regalia. Any transgression of these dress rules will be reported in writing to the Club concerned.
